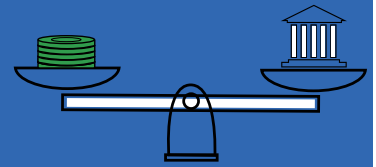


## Workshop

#### The Course - October 10, 2019

This module provides an overview of the administrative, financial and legal management of European projects in the field of research and innovation.

The training module contributes to FASTER's objectives regarding the need to increase the administrative and financial capacity during project implementation. The first part of the module addresses the planning of a European project budget according to the main administrative, financial and legal rules of European programs.

The last part of the module will analyse the strategies used to monitor the project development as well as the production and delivery of project financial reports for the European Commission. The sessions aim at providing hands-on experience by working on examples
